Teachers will provide families with additional materials as needed for academics. The school will offer four family events concentrating on building parent capacity. Parent nights will include topics such as, Open House/Title I night, EL Night, Testing Information Night and Literacy Night. Teachers will provide weekly newsletters that feature games and activities the families can play to review math concepts and reinforce reading skills being covered in class as well as hold conferences as needed. Teachers at CCES will communicate by using text and voice messages or apps such as Remind or Class Dojo as additional communication tools.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

We, as parents, will:

Have fun with math. Try to attend family academic events and/or participate in virtual family events held at the school or get the resources provided from the teacher if unable to attend. Play word games with new vocabulary words and find ways to use these words in family conversations. Look for the class newsletter and check out the school website and Facebook page for updates.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

Students will bring home the class newsletter featuring vocabulary word games and will play these games at home with their families to gain practice using the vocabulary words and discuss math learned at school. Bring home notices about family-school events.
